Privacy Policy

LDC understands how important privacy is to our members. We are committed to protecting your privacy and want to make sure that you understand how your membership information is used. We also want you to be aware that you have choices about how we use this information.

What Information We Collect. When you apply for membership, we ask for basic information such as your name, address, telephone number(s), email address(s), LDC committee interest and family member names (which are included in the LDC Family Membership). We keep track of your participation in LDC activities, membership dues and member services (i.e., LDC Website, LDC listserve) so we can understand our members' interests and evaluate the effectiveness of our offerings.

Information Sharing. We share the information we collect only with organizations that we are required by organizational affiliation to share (i.e. 11th District Democratic Party, Michigan Democratic Party, etc.). The LDC will also share the contact information you designate the LDC can share with those activities approved by the membership and executive board of the LDC (i.e., sharing information with LDC endorsed candidates). The LDC may release member information on the rare occasions when we are required to do so by law, or when necessary or appropriate to comply with legal process or to protect or defend LDC and its members. The LDC will not sell or rent member information to telemarketers, mailing list brokers, or any other companies that are not offering LDC endorsed services or benefits.

Your Choices. We respect your choices. If you do not want us to share your information you can contact us as specified below. At any time you can indicate or change your choices to share the information the LDC collects via the LDC Membership form.
